ACCESS TO NON-URGENT EPISODIC CARE JUNE THROUGH SEPTEMBER 2017

Cottage Country Family Health Team (CCFHT) – 5 Pineridge Gate, Gravenhurst, Ontario is providing...

Access to **non-urgent care for sudden onset illnesses, infections, and minor injuries** at its Gravenhurst site each Saturday in July and August, beginning July 8th, from 9 am to 4 pm (closed for lunch 12:00 pm to 12:30 pm). **This service is available to CCFHT Physician-rostered patients, CCFHT and Health Hub Nurse Practitioner-registered patients AND seasonal/visiting patients who have a primary care provider outside of Muskoka.** Specific dates of service are:

- **July 8, 15, 22, and 29, 2017, and**
- **August 5, 12, 19, and 26, 2017.**

Call **705-687-2271** on the Saturday of service to book an appointment for that day.

NOTE: **patients will be seen for non-urgent care such as sudden onset illness, infections, and minor injuries. This service is not intended for patients who are unable to get an appointment with their Physician or Nurse Practitioner on a day of their choosing during the week.**

Port Carling Health Hub – 147-3 Medora Street, Port Carling, Ontario is providing...

Access to **non-urgent episodic care for sudden onset illnesses, infections, and minor injuries** at its Port Carling site three days/week (**Thursday, Friday, AND Saturday**) throughout June, July, and August, from 9 am to 4 pm (closed for lunch from 12:00 pm to 12:30 pm). **This service is available to seasonal/visiting patients who have a primary care provider outside of Muskoka.** Specific dates of service are:

- **June 8 – 10, 15 – 17, 22 – 24, and 29 - 30, 2017**
- **Closed July 1, 2017**
- **July 6 – 8, 13 – 15, 20 – 22, and 27 – 29, 2017**
- **August 3 – 5, 2017**
- **Closed August 10 – 12, 2017**
- **August 17 – 19, 24 – 26, and August 31, 2017**
- **September 1 - 2, and September 7 – 9, 2017.**

Call **705-765-7665** on the Thursday, Friday, or Saturday of service to book an appointment for that day.
